A look at a handy little app designed to help you bypass commitments

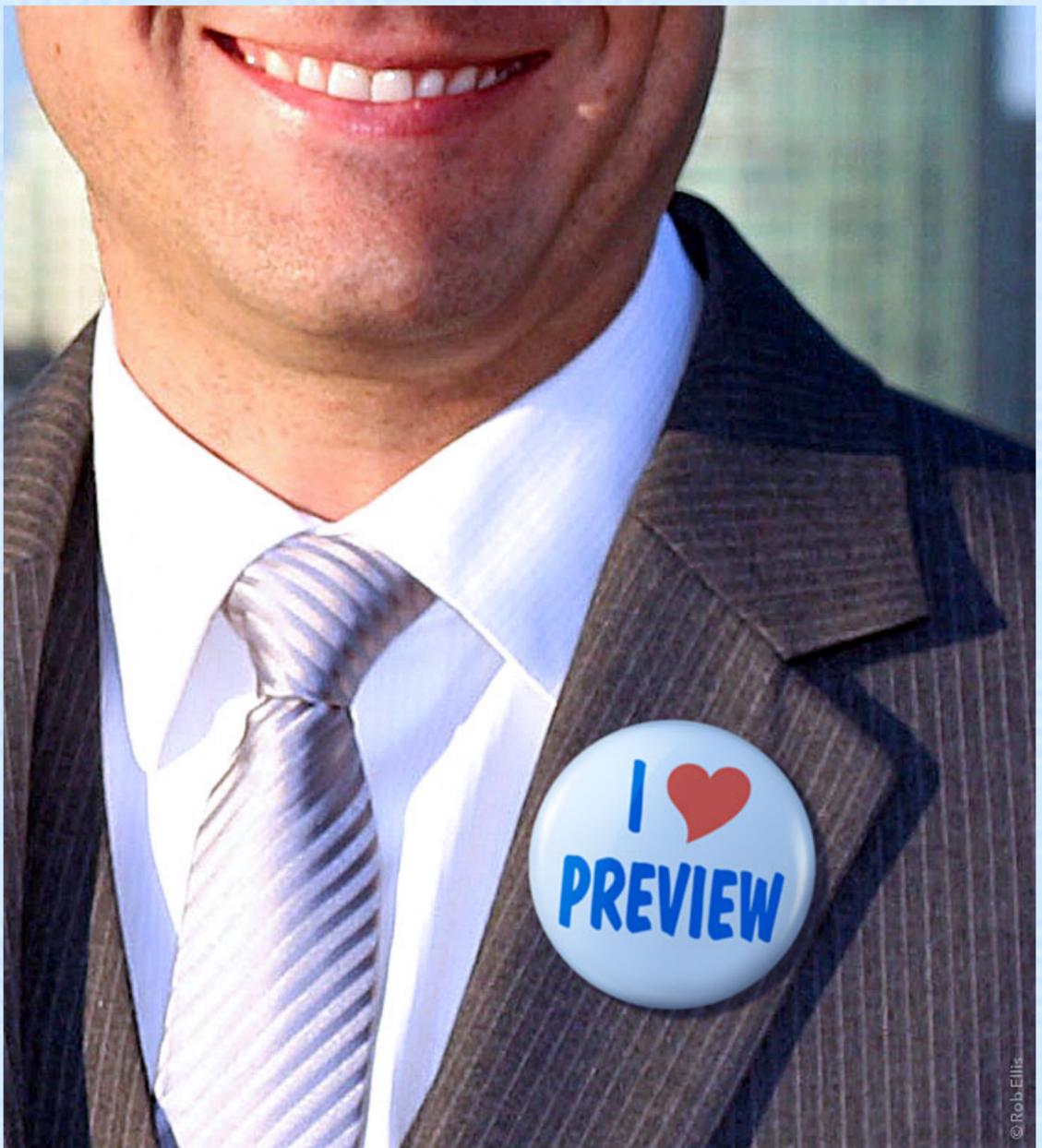
If you are weary of being pinned down to various events, duties and obligations to which you have recklessly agreed, then Tuesday's meeting is right up your alley. iMight, which works with the Calendar app on your Mac, makes it easy to send noncommittal messages in response to requests or expectations. Simply add an event to your calendar, and iMight will automatically send a message or email to the appropriate recipient, letting them know that you "might" attend an event or complete a task. And if you sign up for an optional account, iMight can send noncommittal postcards and letters via the postal service — perfect for replying to wedding invitations. And now you can avoid commitments on the go with iMight for iPhone, or you can even take it a step further by using iMight's brand-new sister app: iMightNot.

On Tuesday, we will show how to use the iMight apps on your Mac or iOS device. We will also discuss the fact that today is April Fools' day...

A good look at features and functions in Apple's Preview app

First impressions are sometimes erroneous and usually incomplete, and this certainly applies to this month's featured app: Preview. Much like last month's TextEdit, Preview has far more capabilities than are readily apparent. Besides opening images or PDFs, with Preview, you can convert an image file to an impressive number of other image formats, tweak images by adjusting color, brightness and many other aspects, perform functions on PDFs including cropping and password-protecting, and much more. On Tuesday, Tom will guide us through several of the remarkable features in Preview, some of which you might grow to love. Though you might not find yourself in a torrid affair with Preview, it could, at the very least, be the beginning of a beautiful friendship.
