

HOW TO LEARN STUFF

Modern instructional and learning resources, available through your Mac, iPhone, or iPad, for learning just about anything you want to be presented by **Tom Davis and Annette Davis**



Suppose you would love to learn how to play acoustic or electric guitar, or improve your photography, or learn poker theory and analysis, or take a course on meditation. How might you learn the things you want to learn? In 2019, the world is filled with incredible, not-quite-traditional learning resources which did not exist a few years ago. On Tuesday, Tom and Annette will each demonstrate amazing avenues for learning. Tom will show off Apple's own free iTunes U, which, besides the topics above, provides thousands more, including courses from many universities such as Ohio State, West Point, Stanford, and University of South Wales; audio and video lectures; courses on developing iOS apps; podcasts from the Library of Congress and museums; resources for students; woodworking courses; piano tutorials; drawing classes; courses for learning Spanish or Chinese; and virtual field trips to museums, parks, and historic sites. Tom will also show other online resources, such as YouTube instructional videos, podcasts covering an extraordinary number of subjects, and college and library resources. Annette will demonstrate the Osmo, which gently attaches to an iPad, and allows you to interact with actual game pieces, puzzles and drawing surfaces, all of which can be touched, moved and manipulated on the table in front of you. As you will see, the Osmo brings new meaning to the term, "hands-on". Annette will also show two new games for Osmo: Pizza Co, and Coding Adventures with Awbie. If you would love to learn where to find new nourishment for your mind, and have fun in the process, our April meeting is the perfect destination.
