CATCHING UP ON APPLE'S NEWEST OS UPDATES

A look at the features in the latest versions of iOS and macOS to be presented by Tom Davis



Playing "catch-up" may not usually be your idea of a rousing good time, but Tuesday's meeting may be a pleasant exception, because Apple's most recent versions of its operating systems for Macs and iPhones sport some very cool features. On Tuesday, Tom will show us many of the new bells and whistles in macOS Catalina and iOS 13, including Sidecar, which lets you use your iPad as a second Mac display; Screen Time for monitoring Mac app usage and setting family limits; Dark Mode for your iPhone to make things easier on your eyes and less intrusive to those around you; various improvements in Notes, Reminders, Photos, Safari, and Mail; and solutions to a few riddles, such as what exactly happens when you upgrade, and why iTunes has disappeared from your Mac, leaving in its place four new apps called Music, Books, Podcasts, and TV. If you have not already updated, all of this information can help you decide whether you would like to spring for the updates, as well as help you catch up on what is new.
