

With the assumption that it is no more than a lowly, bare-bones text editor, many Mac users are only marginally aware of TextEdit, which appears when we double-click a text or 'Read Me' file, then vanishes into the shadows. But if you write, make notes, keep lists of any kind, do research, or long to recall where you left off at your favorite websites, a gem lies waiting for you in your Applications folder. TextEdit makes easy work of creating text in many colors and styles, checking word meanings and accessing web info, doing inline photos, tables, text inventories of folder contents, bulleted and numbered lists, and far more. Once you know how, you can find, and see, your passwords using the Keychain Access app, and also via Safari's preferences.
