How to use iMovie (which is already on your Mac) to create spectacular-looking movies to be presented by Roger Owens

Whether or not your masterpiece leads to your brushing shoulders with Scarlett Johansson and Leonardo DiCaprio at the Golden Globe Awards, the journey is bound to be rewarding. On Tuesday, Roger will show how you can use iMovie to, for example, make YouTube videos, create simple music videos, document your kid's parties or your vacations, or pitch your product. We will see how to import videos from various sources such as cameras, phones and pads, how to import slide shows from iPhoto or Photos, and learn how easy it is to record footage and voiceovers within iMovie, trim, crop and merge clips, add titles and transitions, and share all this with friends. Armed with barely more than a Mac and perhaps an optional director's chair, in no time you too can hear your overwrought leading lady purr, "Alright Mr. DeMille, I'm ready for my close-up."
